Anishinabe Language Classes Also Planned For March

TOWER, Minn. – The ancient art of storytelling will come to life as the Bois Forte Heritage Center presents *Storytelling Under The Stars* on Tuesday, March 6, from 7 to 8 p.m.

“I invite everyone to come, listen and witness the unfolding of our heritage in these ancient stories presented by Karen and Lester Drift,” said Rose Berens, Director of the Heritage Center. “It will be a truly magical evening.”

Anishinabe language classes are also planned for Tuesday, March 20, from 7 to 9 p.m.

Both events are free to the public, and all ages are welcome.

There will also be an Anishinabe language CD available at the Heritage Center gift shop. The CD was produced by Karen Drift, known throughout the state as a teacher and champion of the Ojibwe language, and Keith Secola, national recording artist known for celebrating his native heritage in music.

Dedicated to telling the Bois Forte Ojibwe story, the Heritage Center (Atisokanigamig or LEGEND HOUSE) is nationally recognized for its interpretative displays and educational programs.
