

## **Enforcement Update**

**Start- Wednesday, September 2, 2020.**

**Hours- 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM.**

**Paddles ONLY first two (2) days. (9-2-2020 & 9-3-2020)**

**DNR will be buying rice on 9-6-2020, 3:00PM-6:00PM. \$3.00 per pound.**

**Conservation Officers will be asking for permits through-out the ricing season and while DNR is buying rice at the water quality building.**

**Valid form of identification needed.**

**It is up to you and your ricing partner to make sure you both have ricing permits. If one (1) or both don't have a rice permit the rice will be seized and persons will be fined.**

**DNR will have drones patrolling the lake.**

**A rice permit is REQUIRED before you rice.**

**Conservation Officers will be at Water Quality Garage starting 9/2/2020 at 8:00 AM**

**\$15- Bois Forte Band members. A Valid Identification need.**

**\$15- Resident Tribal. Flat rate, no discount for age/student.**

**\$1- Senior. 55 years old. Anyone born on 9/2/1965 or earlier.**

**\$30- Special. A permit that was requested to the Conservation Committee to hunt/gather/fish.**

**\$1- Student. Needs a student ID or College ID number.**
