Three years ago, legislation was introduced to create a task force to study the **Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women of Minnesota**. Last year, that bill was passed with the support of the community and Gov. Walz signed it into law. With a variety of partnerships, the Department of Public Safety Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women's Task Force has made significant progress. Unfortunately, due the pandemic, we are not able to hold public forums and community listening sessions.
