**\*\*Please remember that because ID's are being issued offsite, I will not have access to individual enrollment files, therefore it is very important to bring one of the listed documents\*\***

**Please bring one of the following documents (photocopies are not accepted):**

- Certified birth record issued by a government bureau of vital statistics or board of health in the United States, District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, or United States Virgin Islands.
- State issued driver's license, driver's permit or identification card with picture that is not expired for more than five (5) years.
- Valid INS Certificate of Citizenship.
- Valid, unexpired United States passport.
- Unexpired active duty, reserve or retired U.S military identification card (DD-2 or Geneva Conventions Common Access Card).
- One of the following valid, unexpired documents issued by the U.S. Department of Justice or U.S. Department of Homeland Security:
  - a) Employment Authorization Card with photo (I-688 or I-766 series)
  - b) Certificate of Citizenship (N-560, N-561, or N-645)
  - c) United States Citizen Identification card (I-179 or I 197)
  - d) Northern Mariana Card (I-873)
  - e) American Indian Card (I-872)

**The following are not acceptable forms of ID to obtain a Tribal ID:**

- 1854 Treaty Authority Cards
- Yellow receipt from the DMV **without** the clipped ID card
- Photocopies of any kind

If you are in need of a replacement Tribal ID, there is a \$12.00 replacement fee. The replacement fee includes any change that is needed.
