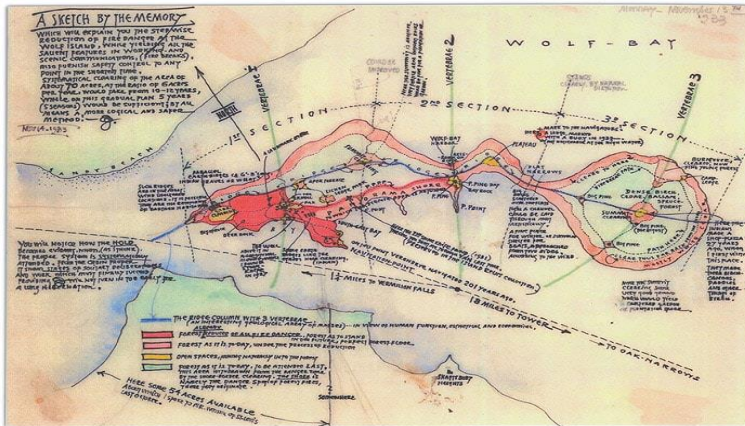


# BOIS FORTE HERITAGE CENTER & CULTURAL MUSEUM



Wolf Island is a place of legend and lore, holding the footprints of both Native Americans and Voyageurs. The Trust for Public Land (TPL) has taken advantage of a one-time opportunity to protect this prominent archeological site in the middle of Lake Vermilion, one of the premier lakes located in the Minnesota north woods. Wolf Island, also known as Knotts Island, is located at the lake's north end where the Vermilion River flows northward from Wolf Bay.
